

Tuition Waiver for Dependent Children of Retrenched Full Time AFT Faculty and Professional Staff

The University and Union agree that:

A. Eligibility and Criteria

- The dependents of retrenched full time AFT faculty and professional staff maybe eligible to receive a tuition waiver if they are enrolled in regularly scheduled courses; provided available classroom space permits and tuition-paying students constitute the minimum number required for the course.
Dependents of retrenched full time AFT faculty and professional staff with ten years of service with the University are eligible for a tuition waiver under this program within a 5-year period from effective date of retrenchment. This benefit applies whether or not the AFT faculty or professional staff member is tenured or on multi-year contracts.
- Dependents of AFT faculty or professional staff members with less than ten years of service are eligible for a tuition waiver under this program for the period of time the retrenched employee is on the reemployment list in accordance with Art. XLI A (10).
- Registration for dependents is permitted starting on the first day of add/drop per the academic calendar. Dependents who register for classes prior to or after that date will forfeit their right to receive a waiver under the program for that semester or for those courses.
- Only the cost of tuition will be waived under this program. The student is responsible for all mandatory and course related fees.
- This program is only applicable to a first undergraduate degree. Doctoral and masters programs are excluded.
- Matriculated undergraduate students under this program are responsible for filing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.gov) and providing all requested information to the Office of Financial Aid to determine financial aid eligibility.
- All waivers will be reduced by State or Federal Student Financial Aid, grants and scholarship awards.
- If you are a matriculated student, and are eligible for a grant, you will be required to use the grant(s) first to cover the program cost and you may register for classes covered by such grant(s) under regular registration timelines.

- Dependents under this program are subject to William Paterson University's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for Financial Aid. In order to participate in the program, the student must be making academic progress toward a degree and cannot be in default of a student loan.


B. Exemptions

- Customized courses underwritten by specific employers are exempt from eligibility under this program.
- Courses offered under the Continuing Education, Study Abroad and National Student Exchange Program (NSE) programs are exempt from eligibility under this tuition waiver program.
